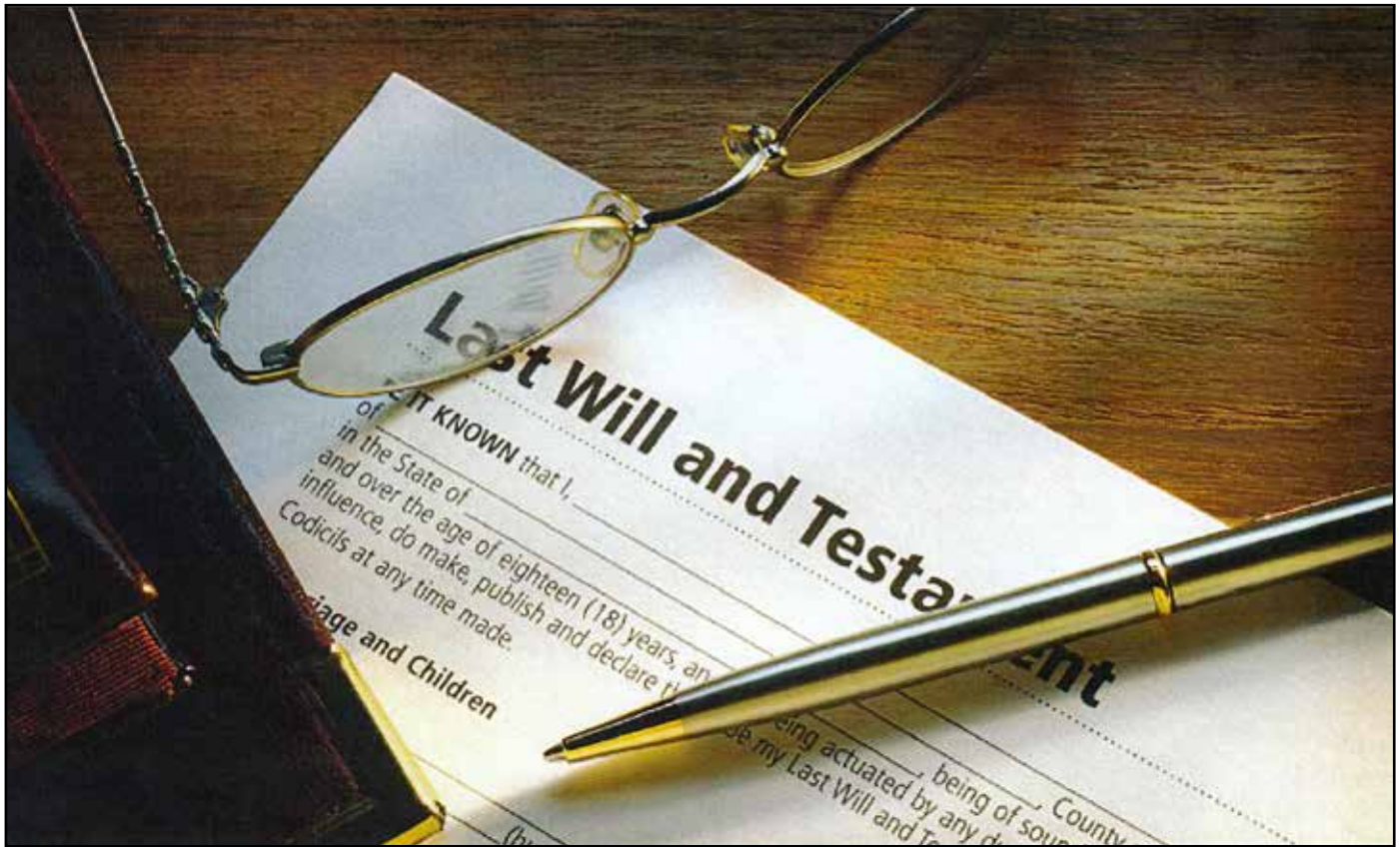


BEQUEST GIFTS TO GREAT COMMISSION MEDIA MINISTRIES
