
Young people are seeking—and we have the answer

Hannu Haukka and Hani Henein recently returned from Egypt, where preparations for the media campaign are well underway. After the trip, Hani shared how both the vision for the campaign and preparations are progressing.

Born and raised in Egypt, Hani has carried a vision in his heart for years, which is now becoming a reality. Although Hani now lives in Finland and leads the Arab work at our ministry centre, he has never forgotten his homeland.

- When I walk along the streets of Egypt, the same ones where I grew up, strongly reminds me of how deep a longing people have to encounter the living God. This mission is not just a task for me: it is a personal calling that has been with me for years.

According to Hani, we are living in a special moment right now. The younger generation of Egypt is searching for meaning and truth amid an uncertain world.

- There is a huge spiritual hunger in Egypt. Many young people are searching for a genuine touch of God amidst the chaos. Social media is their arena, and that is where we can meet them in a way that really speaks to them.

This is not a momentary enthusiasm. The campaign has been prepared with prayer and planning for a long time, and now the work is taking shape. Christians from different denominations are doing something unique together.

- We have been praying for this vision for years. Now is the time to act. We are seeing different churches unite around a common goal—not for their own glory, but for the sake of the kingdom of God.

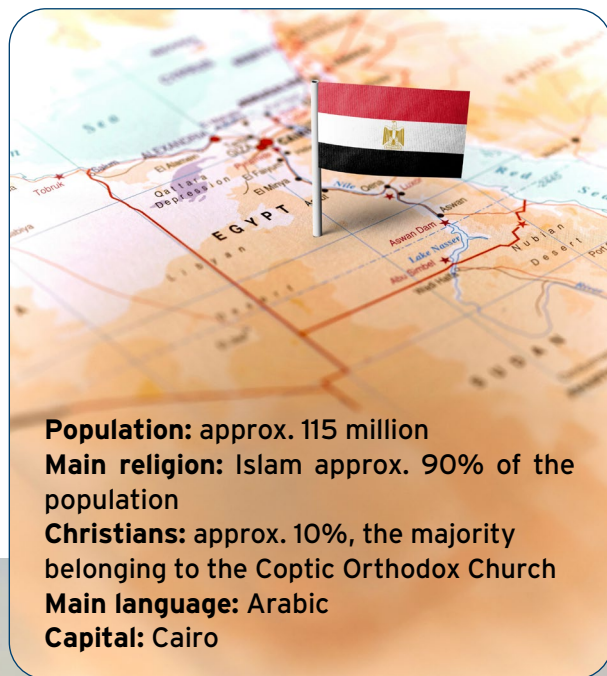

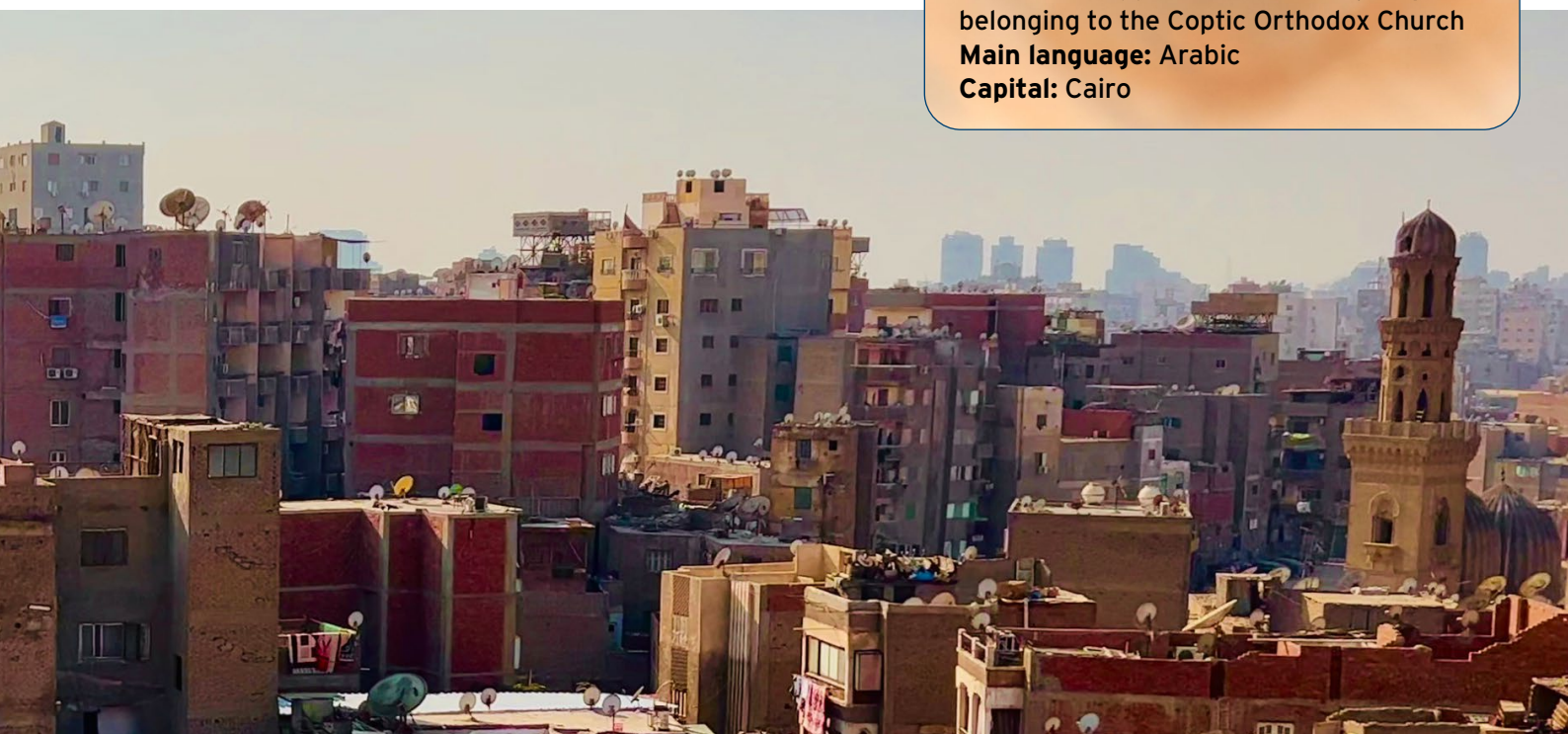


The Campaign in a Nutshell

- The campaign covers all of Egypt
- Duration: approximately 4 months
- Follow-up: personal contact for everyone who shows interest
- Channels: Satellite TV, social media, printed life-changing stories, multiple call centers
- The campaign starts in Cairo, but the goal is to reach the entire country



Population: approx. 115 million
Main religion: Islam approx. 90% of the population
Christians: approx. 10%, the majority belonging to the Coptic Orthodox Church
Main language: Arabic
Capital: Cairo
