At present, GCM is fully engaged on several strategic fronts in Ethiopia, Israel, Iran, Moldova, and Ukraine.

100 Million Spiritually Hungry People in Ethiopia

Ethiopia has a population of approximately 139 million people. The most significant ethnic groups are the Oromo, Amhara and Somali peoples.

I just returned from a meeting with Ethiopian Christian leaders. Ethiopian church leaders have set a bold goal to see 4 million new baptized be-



lievers between 2026-2029. We can be sure that it greatly pleases God to see holy boldness, courageous faith in action.

Throughout Scripture, God has a history of embracing enormous challenges. In John 3:16, God so loved the whole world that He gave His one and only Son, that no one should perish! We are privileged to be ambassadors on God's behalf.



Anxiety and stress in Israel are on the increase uncontrollably. Even when the sirens are silent, the war continues to rage in hearts and minds. Dr. Cohen (in Israel) has stated that long after the air alerts have fallen silent, the war within continues. The path back to normality, back to life as it was before the war, is long.

Three Million People Suffer from the Trauma of War

Three million Israelis are living with the trauma of war. A missionary friend who lives in Galilee, recently wrote:

"In the early morning hours of February 28, rockets began raining down from Iran. Initially, they targeted the north, including our area, making it nearly impossible to leave the bomb shelter for two days.

Then the same happened in Tel Aviv, Haifa, and then across the entire country. More than 5,000 missiles and drones have been launched toward Israel from Iran and Lebanon."

100,000 Air Raid Alerts

Across the country, air raid alerts have already been triggered nearly 100,000 times, at all hours of the day and night.

It is no wonder that this creates anxiety for many. More than 7,000 people have been wounded.

Thousands of Israelis have been temporarily displaced from their homes to hotels because of severe damage to their homes due to missile strikes.

Living in a constant state of stress in Israel have caused many to reflect on the deeper meaning of life.

Many people have turned to search for hope and a future. Let us continue to uphold Israel in prayer during these challenging times.

The Symptoms of War Related Trauma

The most common symptoms of war include anxiety, grief, tension, insomnia, emotional exhaustion, mood swings, a lack of hope for the future, suicidal thoughts, restlessness, eating disorders, anxiety, fearfulness, and difficulty in concentration.

Israeli psychiatrist Cohen has confirmed that three million Israelis are suffering from symptoms of the war.

Even when the sirens grow quiet, the war continues in the heart and mind. The journey back to life as it was before the war will be a long one.

Yet in the middle of this hardship, a unique opportunity has opened to reach three million Israelis with the message God's healing word.

"God's Psychiatry" To Be Available in Hebrew

The recently published book in Ukraine is being translated into Hebrew and its stories of recovery will be adapted to resonate with the Israeli population.

The same book will be available in Russian as well for the two million Russian Jews who have immigrated to Israel and now live in Israel.

GCM has received news that about 300 Messianic congregations will partner in the outreach to those very millions of lives that have been shaken by the war with Iran, Hezbollah and Hamas.



The Republic of Moldova finds itself in Russia's sights both politically and militarily. We need to act swiftly regarding this time-sensitive campaign.

Moldova, Recovering From Former Communist Russian Rule

In May, preparations have been launched for a nationwide evangelism outreach in Moldova.

Moldova was part of the atheistic Soviet Union before the USSR collapsed in 1991. Now the nation is embracing the idea of an "all-out" time-sensitive nationwide evangelism campaign.

Moldovan pastors met recently to advance the vision of their nation responding to the Gospel.

The group of leaders was led by EU parliament member and senior pastor Valeriu Ghilechi.

Pastor Valeriu strongly encouraged his country's churches to press ahead with this unique but time-sensitive opportunity.

Thank you for remembering this important Moldovan campaign in your prayers. Lord willing, the evangelism campaign will take place in late 2026.

The Iranian Opportunity - A God Ordained Open Door

The US-Israeli-Iran war that exploded this past spring has profoundly disrupted international travel and economic stability.

Internally, the Islamic leadership had severed all communication with the outside world including the internet. Yet, providentially one door to Iranian homes remains open.

The Door That No One Can Shut

Currently, the majority of Iranian households have access to satellite TV, despite the official ban on satellite dishes. And satellite TV continues to be a wide-open door into the living rooms of millions of Iranians.

GCMM's Farsi-language (Iranian) television ministry penetrates barriers that the religious establishment could not seal off. More than ten million satellite dishes are in use throughout the country.



GCMM's TV studio in Finland produces 300 Farsi-language Christian television programs annually—roughly one new program every weekday.



Millions In Ukraine Need Healing From the Trauma Of War

Four years of devastating war and counting in Ukraine have left multitudes of lives desolate.

According to the World Health Organization, at least 10 million Ukrainians suffer from war-related trauma. The initial printing of 10,000 copies of the GCM “trauma book” has already been distributed, with hundreds of thousands of copies still needed.

The book contains “God’s Psychiatry”, which is found in Psalm 23, based on David’s personal experience as he passes through the valley as dark as death. He proclaims that his Shepherd restores, and fixes the broken, wounded soul.
